Subject: Telemedicine in Kosovo

The grant supports a two-year program to improve health care delivery through telemedicine and leadership training in Kosovo. The project will also include outreach to Albania, Macedonia, and Montenegro. Activities include a series of exchanges that will bring participants to Arizona and Alaska to examine such topics as hospital management, medical training, clinical practices and telemedicine techniques. In addition, U.S. experts will travel to the region to conduct workshops on: e-health and virtual medical library training; trauma physician and nursing leadership training; and other virtual education programs. Funding will also provide partial support for the installation of computer equipment in four telemedicine centers in Kosovo.
